Oxon is a large primary school with approximately 420 children on roll. It is situated on the western side of Shrewsbury in an area that has seen a considerable number of new houses built in the last thirty years. Over that time the school has grown from two classes to fourteen classes.

The appointment would be for 24.75 hours per week and would involve working with Key Stage 1 children.

The person appointed would also be asked to work as a lunchtime supervisor for one hour each day in addition to these hours and that would be paid at Level 1.

A contract at Level 2 is dependent on the applicant holding the relevant NVQ 2 qualification or an equivalent, applicants without the qualification would be paid at Level 1.
